

USER MANUAL

NETWORK SOFTWARE, **REMOTE DISPLAY** CAN GENERATE THE DISPLAY OF RANKINGS AND TRACKING ON TV OR PC SCREENS ON 10 DIFFERENT CHANNELS AND SIMULTANEOUSLY.

THIS SOFTWARE CAN WORK LOCALLY, THAT IS WITH ELITE V3 ON THE SAME COMPUTER, OR NETWORK (RJ45).

DISPLAY SETTINGS ARE SPECIFIC TO A FOLDER, AND SPECIFIC TO A TYPE OF RACE (BEST LAP RANKING, NUMBER OF LAPS, ETC.). SO, YOU NEED TO GO INTO THE FOLDER SETTINGS TO MANAGE THE DISPLAY.

HOW DOES THE SOFTWARE WORK WITH ELITE V3

STEP1: ENABLE CHANNELS

In ELITE V3, you must ENABLE CHANNEL 1. Here, we manage a single channel.

STEP 2 : CHANGE THE LOCAL PORT NETWORK

By default, the local port network used is **14000**. You can change it if the port was already being used by another application.

STEP 3 : WINDOWS DISPLAY SETTINGS

To have your display on a computer screen connected to the VGA, DVI or HDMI port from your computer, right-click on the desktop of your computer and choose DISPLAY SETTINGS and EXTEND THESE DISPLAYS.

IN THE REMOTE DISPLAY SOFTWARE

STEP 4 : IP ADDRESS AND REMOTE PORT

You must use the **IP address 127.000.000.1** and the **remote port 14000** (*the same is entered in the ELITE V3* software) and select **CHANNEL 1** which was validated in **ELITE V3**. **Fill the screen number** (*in Windows, see on previous page*) and in this example, **Screen 2**.

CHECK THAT THE 'ENABLE SCREEN' BOX IS STILL CHECKED.

Validate your settings by clicking on APPLY.

IN THE REMOTE DISPLAY SOFTWARE

STEP 5 : CUSTOMIZE YOUR DISPLAY

In **OPTIONS** tab of REMOTE DISPLAY, you can customize your view using the menu **SELECT AN IMAGE**.

Then give the access pattern of the desired image by clicking on the icon FOLDER *i* Validate your choices by clicking on **APPLY**.



Settings, Green flag, Yellow flag, Stop Race... displays an image on your screen 2 automatically when ordering **ELITE V3** software. Example below with a Green flag:

PREDEFINED IMAGES

In the default directory [C:\ProgramData\Chronelec\RemoteDisplay\Images], you will see the content of the folder IMAGES which provides a large number of predefined images :



NB : The default software images preceded by a [_] as [_PitIn. png] can be modified but must remain exactly the same heading because these are automatic and direct links related with software commands in ELITE V3.

To change or add images, always store them in the same folder in .PNG

DISPLAY OF IMAGES ON SCREEN 2

To display images on the screen 2, you must first, in the display settings of ELITE V3, select IMAGE

THE MULTIPLE POSSIBILITIES OF THE SOFTWARE

ASSIGN AN IMAGE TO A FIELD

If you want to display images, place **[.PNG]** files in the **IMAGES** folder of the **REMOTE DISPLAY** software. These images will have to be named in the same way as what is indicated in **ELITE V3**.

In the example below, the [NATIONALITY] and [MODEL] fields have an assigned image. For the competitor [N° 111], its fields [NATIONALITY] and [MODEL] are filled with [POL] and [KTM]. The images in the folder must therefore also be named this way.



Check the IMAGE boxes in the ELITE V3 DISPLAY SETTINGS.



When **ELITE V3** software sends information to **REMOTE DISPLAY**, the software will point to the corresponding image if it exists in the **IMAGES** folder and display it. THIS EXAMPLE IS VALID FOR ALL OTHER FIELDS IN ELITE V3 SOFTWARE.







NETWORKING : MULTI-USER CONFIGURATION

All the features of a multi-user configuration remain the same as those of a local configuration. In the example below, the TIMING COMPUTER uses the ELITE V3 software and has activated the 10 TV display channels (see step 1). The other 3 computers, being on the same network, can therefore display one or more of these 10 channels thanks to the **REMOTE DISPLAY** software.

THE IP ADDRESS MUST BE THE ONE OF THE COMPUTER THAT SENDS THE TV DISPLAY INFORMATIONS ON THE NETWORK (TIMING COMPUTER), AND THE PORT MUST CORRESPOND TO THE ONE FILLED ON THE TIMING COMPUTER IN STEP 2 (IN THIS CASE 14000).
